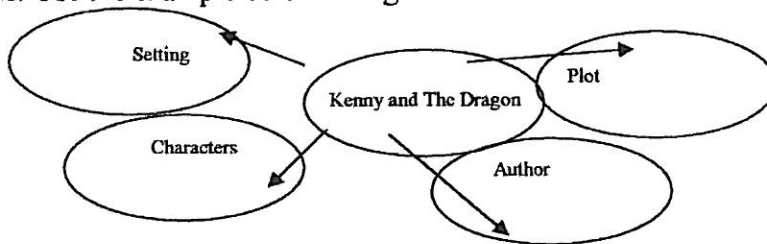

For each book choose one of the following products to show that you have read the book. Vary your products! Be creative and have fun! Staple your two projects to the back of this cover sheet and turn in to your teacher at the Open House or no later than the second day of school. Students will receive a completion grade.

Product Choice:

- Pretend to be a character from one of the books that you read. Write a diary entry as that character. Imagine what that character might feel or think about the events that took place in the book. Write at least two paragraphs as your character.
- Create a graphic organizer or story web about one of the books that you read. The center of the web should be the title of your book. Spokes off of your web should include the author, characters, setting, plot and theme. Use the example below as a guide:



- Create a piece of art that somehow represents the story. On the back of your artwork, explain how your art piece relates to the story. Be sure to include details from the story in your paragraph that make it clear you have read the story.
- Design a new book cover for the story you read. Be sure to include the title, author and featured artwork. On the back jacket of your book cover, include a synopsis of the story as well as a one sentence review.
- Pretend that you are a book critic. Write a review of the book. Make sure that you include a brief summary of the story as well as your personal thoughts and feelings about the book.
